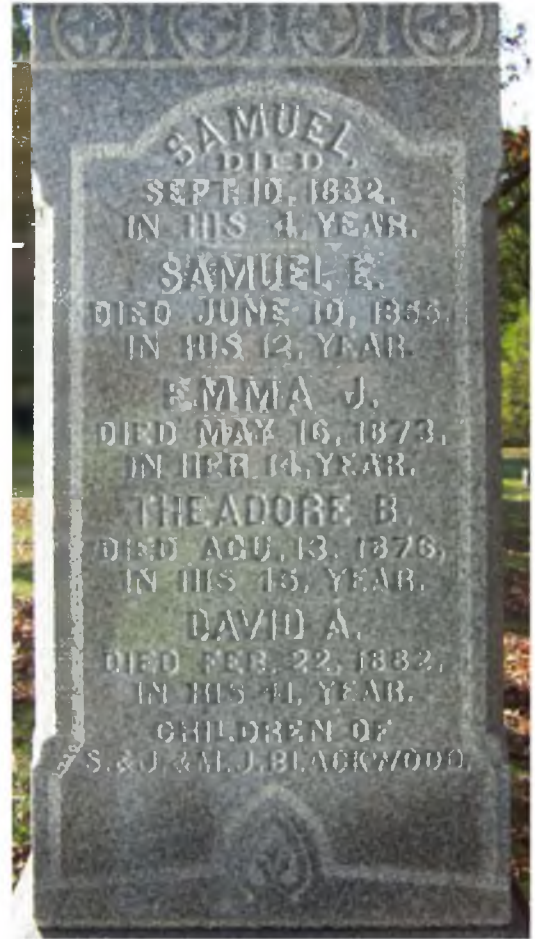

Type of Marker / Monument:

“die in socket”- style footstone

Previous Repairs: The buried socket has cement on it, but the marker is no longer attached to it.

Remarks / Comments: See also Marker 201 (Mary Jane Blackwood). This marker is currently leaning on the Blackwood monument (Marker 201). The socket for this marker was found buried 3 feet north of the “Father” footstone (Marker 201A).
