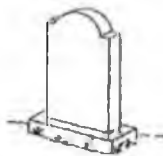

Previous Repairs: This marker was broken at some point, and the top portion of the stone was cemented into its socket. The stone subsequently broke out of its socket and was reassembled again after July 2011.
