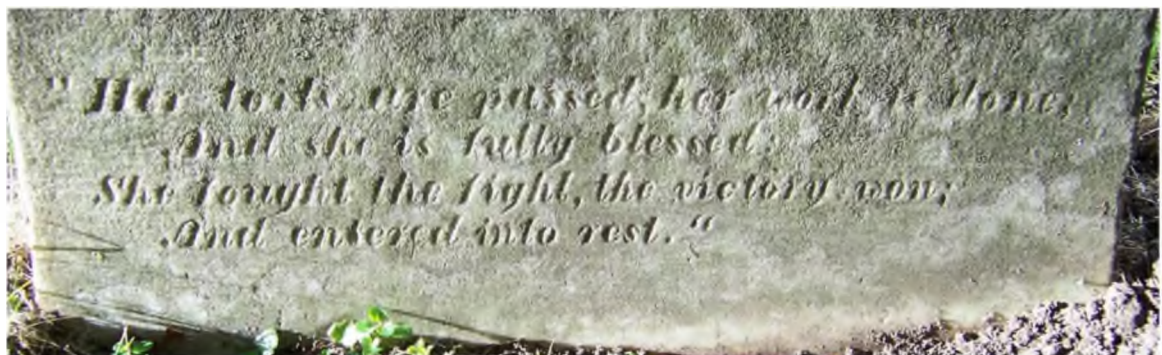
West:
