


Condition of Marker:

- Sound
- Weathered
- Vandalized

- Mower Scars
- Other (describe): The cap piece was originally held in place with pins, but it is no longer attached (see photo).
- Stained / Discolored
- Cracked (at bottom of main stone)
- Unattached to Base
- Repaired
- Loose (not in ground, but marks grave)
- Portions Missing (list):
- Buried
- Broken—# of pieces: 2 + socket pieces
- Overgrown (grass / groundcover)
- Biological (moss / lichen covered)
- Displaced (not marking grave)

Previous Repairs: This marker was originally held in the socket with pins. At some point, the pins failed and cement was used to hold the marker in the socket. The socket is now broken into multiple pieces.

Remarks / Comments: Since the broken socket is nearby, this marker is probably close to the original grave site, but its exact location is unknown.
