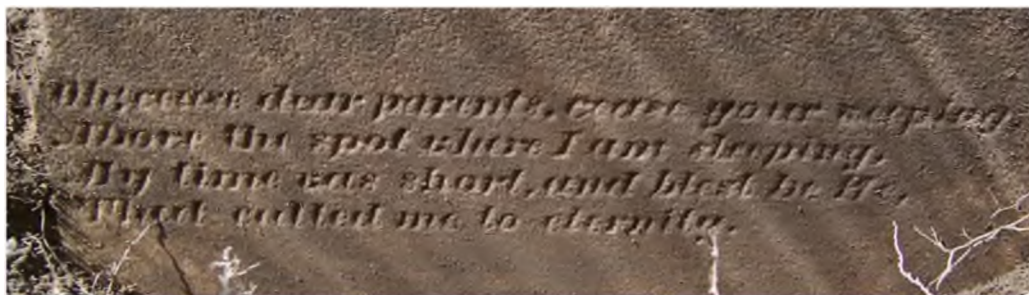


Inscription Transcription and Photo(s):
